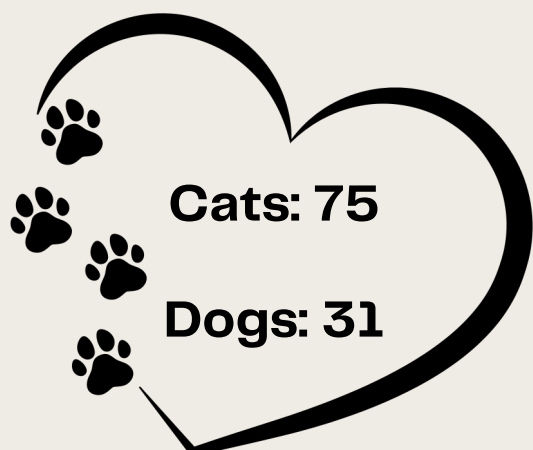

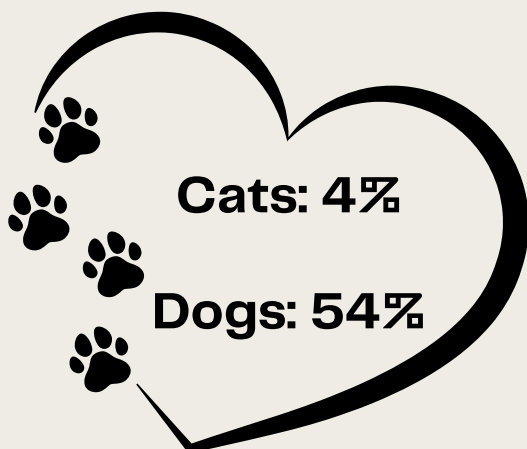

- Essential medical care



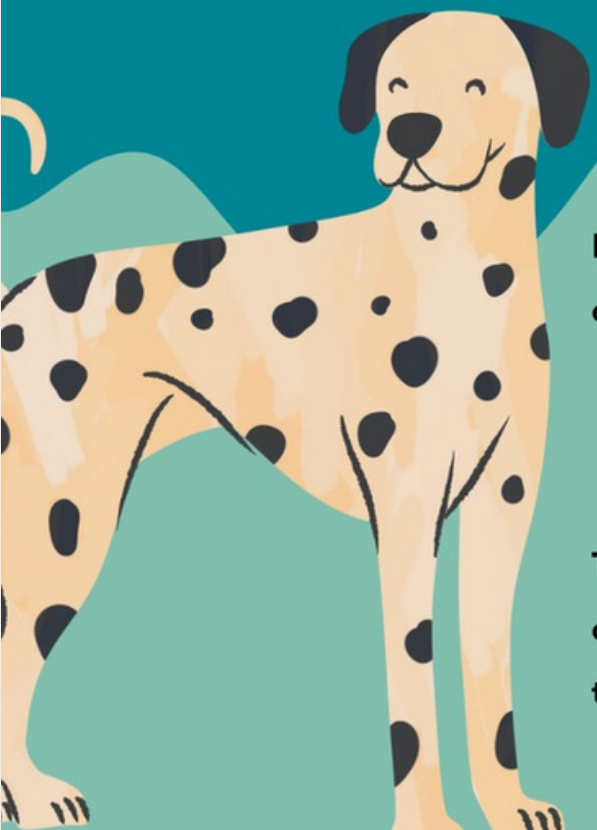
IMPACT OF SPONSORSHIP

- Necessary medical treatment

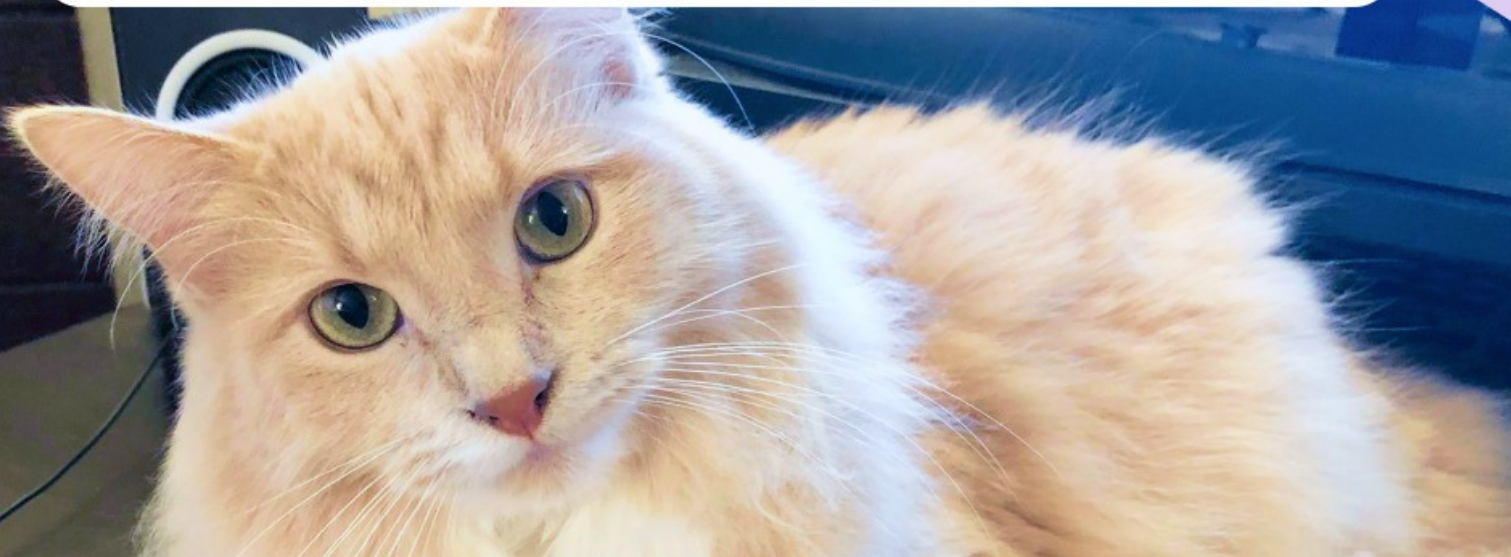

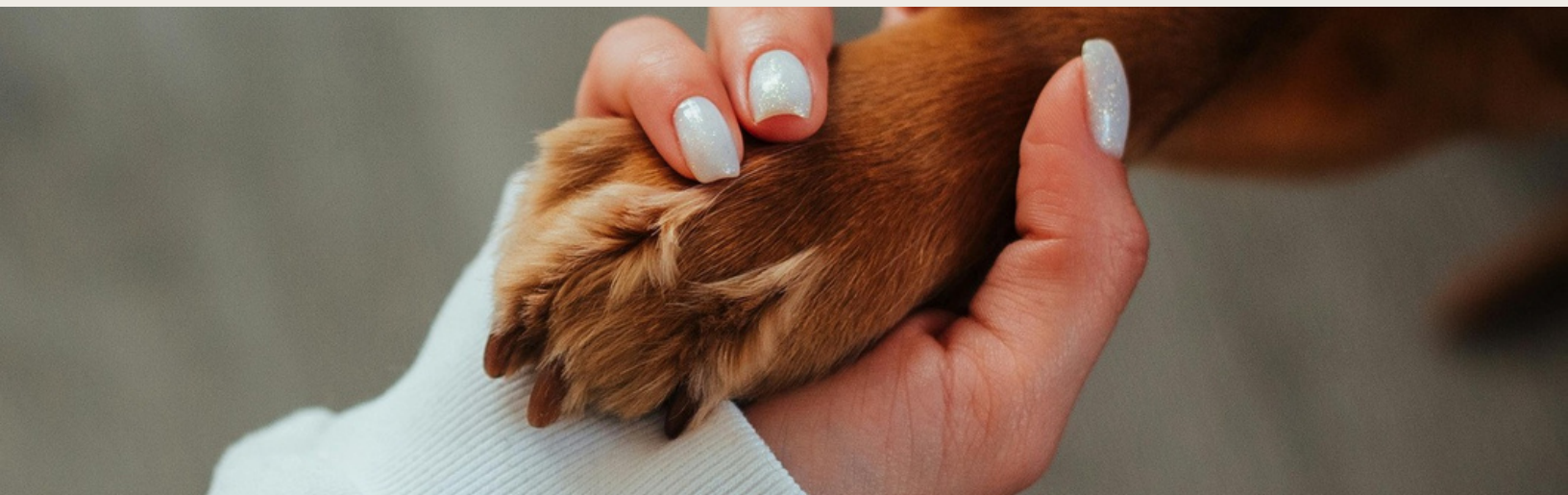
